

There will be no on-site ticket sales for the CHSAA State Swim & Dive Meet. Each competitor will be allowed two spectators to accompany them into the facility for individual events and one spectator for relay events. Cost of a ticket to the meet is \$15 and this cost will be automatically invoiced to each school based on the number of competitors each team has (each individual entry will automatically be billed at a cost of \$30 and relay participants that are not qualified for an individual event will be billed at a cost of \$15). Tickets are transferable and a different person could accompany the athlete in for separate events she has qualified for (this will not increase the cost per athlete). Each athlete will be invoiced at \$30. Anyone competing in only a relay event will be invoiced at \$15. Relay alternates will not be billed.

Immediately after each event, swimmers will exit the pool for the awards ceremony. We will award 1st-10th place with a medal. At the conclusion of the awards ceremony, athletes, coaches, timers and spectators will be required to exit the facility from their designated exit location. Anyone failing to exit the pool will be immediately disqualified from the remainder of the meet.

Entrance & Exit Protocol for Each Event (includes swimmers/divers, coaches, timers/lap counters, spectators):

Diving

- Entry and Warmup begins at 6:15 am.
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitor, coach and maximum 3 spectators (billed for 2 spectators) must all enter at the same time.
- Diver cannot come in without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the athlete; they will NOT be let in after the diver and coach have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all divers, coaches, and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

200 Medley Relay

- Warmup & entry begins at 10:15 am
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- 4 competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 4 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

200 Free

- Warmup begins at 11:15 am
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.

200 IM

- Warmup begins at 11:45 am
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

50 Free

- Warmup begins at 12:15 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.

100 Fly

- Warmup begins at 12:45 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

100 Free

- Warmup begins at 1:15 pm

- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers, lap counters and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

200 Free Relay

- Warmup begins at 2:40 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- 4 competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 4 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

100 Back

- Warmup begins at 3:40 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

100 Breast

- Warmup begins at 4:05 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- Competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 2 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.

400 Free Relay

- Warmup begins at 4:55 pm
- When entering pool deck, place your belongings along the south wall (see diagram) in one of the marked spaces.
- 4 competitors, 1 coach, 1 timer and maximum 4 spectators must all enter at the same time.
- Swimmers may not enter without their high school certified coach.
- Spectators must come in at the same time as the swimmers; they will NOT be let in after the swimmers, coach and timer have gone into the facility.
- Immediately following the awards ceremony for the event, all swimmers, coaches, timers and spectators must exit the facility through the designated exits.
